

EPISODE #10 Work from Home: Are Musk, Bezos and Zuck Right?

From our episode, Work from Home: Are Musk, Bezos and Zuck Right?, here are some data points on how businesses have benefited from a work-from-home workforce:

- A study by Stanford University found that remote workers were 13% more productive than their office-bound counterparts.
- A study by the Society for Human Resource Management found that 77% of remote workers are happy with their work-life balance.
- A study by the Harvard Business Review found that businesses that offer remote work options have a 25% lower turnover rate than businesses that do not.

The projected work from home workforce in 5 years is expected to be around 36.2 million workers or 22% of the American workforce. This is an 87% increase from pre-pandemic levels.
